



2024 - 2025 Scholarship Application Eligibility Criteria

The purpose of the Roswell Woman's Club Scholarship is to recognize and reward outstanding and deserving graduating seniors. The goal of the Roswell Woman's Club is to assist graduating high school seniors with their higher learning objectives. The scholarship award/amount varies based on the proceeds from our fundraisers.

Applicant Eligibility Criteria

- Must be a U.S. citizen or a lawful permanent resident.
- Must reside or attend school in Fulton County *north* of the Chattahoochee River. The address on the high school transcript will determine eligibility.
- Must be a graduating senior from a public or private secondary school or be home schooled in the calendar year in which the application is submitted.
- Must be planning to attend college, university, vocational, or technical school full time in the year of the submitted application.
- Must submit the application and supporting documents by the published deadline date.
- Must not be a child/grandchild or other close relative of an RWC member.
- Must not be the recipient of another scholarship providing complete financial support.

The RWC scholarship is a one-time, non-renewable scholarship.

Scholarships will be awarded without discrimination on the basis of race, color, religion, gender, disability, or national origin.
